Before workshops begin, you will be sent a term schedule outlining what your child will be doing, and mid-way through the term you will be emailed a workshop report sharing some of the activities in the workshops (as well as some photos!).

In each workshop different themes are explored. Examples include improvisation, mime, movement, script-work, set design, stage-fighting, storytelling or play writing to name but a few! Some of the many aspects our workshops cover are included below.

#### **New Content Cater to Age Group**

Younger actors will focus on developing confidence using the actor's tools – the voice, body and imagination. Older actors will build upon this foundation with more complex and challenging drama skills to become a more skilled performer. Scripts and themes will vary from fresh adaptations of famous stories to original and devised stories are chosen with our actors in mind!

#### Ages 7 to 9

It's time to take a step back from the spot light and discover the world hiding behind the curtain. We'll take turns exploring the different theatre roles and learn the responsibility of leadership as the director, expand our imaginations by creating our very own costumes, set's and scripts, and discovering how everything comes together to bring a show to life!

#### Ages 10 to 12

We will be taking the opportunity to discover and experiment with the art form of physical theatre. Together we will practically explore concepts such as status, body language and physical expression. We will look at how different practitioners such as Philipe Gaulier and classic stories such as Alice in wonderland have developed forms of physical theatre in their work. We will be learning different techniques that include Mask, Mime, and Commedia Del'arte.
